#### 2. Financial Statements

- Fiscal period ends Dec31, therefore reviewing up to Dec'15 only.
- YoY expense differences related to block party, xmas tree lighting, AGM costs
- YoY maintenance increases related to 2014 complaints re lack of maintenance.
- 2015 legal fees related to 2014 AGM where developer had legal representation
- Current 2016 cash balance is ~ \$20k
- Financial reports will be included annually as appendix to AGM minutes
- Discussion Planters were not pursued due to potential visibility/liability issues on concrete
  island. The Aspen HOE made contact w Wentworth HOA to understand how other communities
  view/treat these types of things as an insurable risk. The Wentworth HOA pays an annual
  insurance premium of \$2-3k/yr for this type of thing. Decision taken by the Aspen HOA not to
  proceed further.

# 3. Christmas Lights

- Lights were purchased in 2015 at a cost of ~\$900. These lights are now in storage and available for annual use by the Aspen HOA.
- The Aspen HOA will contract to the have the lights put up at the entrance feature again for December 2016.

- 2016 landscaping costs will be lower than 2015 due to sourcing different contractor and achieving lower rates.
- Comments Confirmed the City of Calgary is responsible for clearing paths behind East backing homes, not associated with HOA. Path maintenance appears to be in good shape, no concerns expressed.

- June block party expense was about \$700. Anticipate continuing with this annual event.
